Your TANDYFAX 1000 fax machine has three special Program keys. This is useful if your frequently need to poll the same group of numbers. You can use these keys to store a sequence, or an additional One-Touch key.

Follow the procedure below to record a number, or a group of numbers, in a Program key.

PRESS

- 1 FUNCTION
- 2 MODE down or up
- 3 START ENTER
- 4 Press one of the Program keys, P1, P2, or P3 Example: P1
- 5 To record a transmission or polling sequence, press 1 for COMM. To record an extra One-Touch key or a One-Touch group of numbers, press 2 for DIALING and go to Step 6b.

Example: 1 for COMM.

6a To record transmission numbers (normal or timer), press 1 for XMIT To record polling numbers, press 2 for Polling

Example: 1 for XMT Example: 1 for POLLING

7a For timer transmission or polling, press 1 for YES. For normal transmission or polling, press 2 and skip to Step 9a

Example: 1 for YES Example: 2 for NO

8a For timer operation, enter the starting time in four digits

Note 1. You cannot record basic transmission settings, such as resolution. 2. You cannot program a key for multi-station transmission.

Using Program Keys

Once you have stored entries in the program keys, you can use the keys as follows:

To poll, simply press the Program key.
