## **Function keys**

Fn +	Result
F2	Show or hide the window for the battery power status.
F3	Enter standby mode.
F4	Enter suspend mode.
F7	Change the display output location.
F8	Switch the screen size to the full screen mode.
F11	Change the power mode.
F12	Enter hibernation mode.
PgUp	Increase the volume.
PgDn	Decrease the volume.
Back Space	Turn off the sound. Note: To turn on the sound, press $Fn + PgUp$ or $Fn + PgDn$ .
